

MOMENCE CITY COUNCIL
Monday, July 30, 2012
Special Session Council Meeting

Time: 6:30 P.M.

The City Council Meeting of the City of Momence was held in the Council Chambers at 123 W. River St., Momence.

Mayor Porter led Council in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Mick Porter called the meeting to order.

Roll was called by the Acting Clerk with Ald. Denton, Straley, Metz, Steele, Kupferer and Puglise present. Also present was Mayor Mick Porter.

Ald. Straley reported that at 6:00 P.M. there had been a meeting for public comment on the 2012 Appropriation Ordinance. Ald. Straley made the motion to approve the 2012 -13 Appropriation Ordinance #738. Ald. Denton seconded the motion with Ald. Denton, Straley, Metz, Steele, Kupferer and Puglise voting yes.

Mayor Porter presented the first reading of the Aggregation Referendum. The ordinance has been looked at by the City Atty. The ordinance must be recorded by Aug. 20 to be put on the Nov. Ballot. The question is --Can the City of Momence have the authority to arrange for supply of electricity for residential and small commercial customers who have not opted out of such programs, -- with a yes or no vote.

Ald. Metz reported on a situation regarding a permit in Momence. Council discussed events which occurred concerning a picket fence built at 425 Railroad Ave. Following discussion, Council decided not to take any action. The Council decision at the previous meeting stands, which requires that the owner remove the picket fence.

Ald. Denton made the motion to adjourn. Ald. Metz seconded the motion with Ald. Denton, Straley, Metz, Steele, Kupferer and Puglise voting yes.
