



WHAT IS SHOW BUS?

It is public transportation available to residents of rural Kankakee County and those in the Kankakee metropolitan area wishing transportation to a rural destination.

WHO CAN RIDE?

EVERYONE can ride. Persons of all ages and income levels may ride. All buses are equipped with lifts for easy wheelchair access.

WHERE ARE PASSENGERS PICKED UP?

For the limited stop service, there are central locations in Kankakee, Sun River Terrace and Momence. Individual pick ups can be arranged by calling the office.

WHAT TIME IS PICK UP?

Please see the enclosed schedule.

HOW CAN RIDES BE ARRANGED?

Riders may catch the service at any of the stops without prior reservations. Requests for individual pick up service must be made by 12:00 noon on the weekday **before** the day of service. The bus will then be scheduled to deviate from the route to accommodate the individual pick up. To make a reservation for the individual service, call the **SHOW BUS** office.

In addition to the limited stop service, **SHOW BUS** provides scheduled days services covering the rural areas of the County. For more information, please call the **SHOW BUS** office and request a brochure.

LIMITED STOP SERVICE

In addition to the following limited stop weekday service between Kankakee and Momence, countywide reservation based service is available. Call the office for more information and to request a brochure.

MONDAY-FRIDAY

The following times are approximate to allow for individual pick ups as required. During heavy demand, more than one bus is used to keep on schedule as closely as possible. Advance reservations must be made to schedule an individual pick up or drop off. Please call the office for details.

Each round trip begins on the hour in Kankakee and ends at approximately fifteen minutes after the hour in Kankakee at the Chestnut/Schuyler location. The first round trip begins in Kankakee at 6:00am and the last round trip begins in Kankakee at 5:00pm.

The first two round trips of the day are listed below as examples.

- 6:00am Kankakee, Chestnut and Schuyler
- 6:10am Sun River Terrace, City Hall
- 6:45am Momence, 501 S. Gladiolus
- 6:50am Momence, 123 W. River
- 7:05am Sun River Terrace, City Hall

Route ends at 7:15am in Kankakee, Chestnut and Schuyler.

SHOW BUS provides door to door service as needed on this limited service. While drivers will assist passengers to the bus, they are not allowed to assist passengers with mobility devices up and down stairs or up and down non standard ramps.

All vehicles are equipped with lifts or ramps that accommodate common wheelchairs and weights up to 600 lb. Lift chairs are provided for ambulatory passengers who wish to use the lift.

Drivers will assist with grocery sized packages and will provide assistance as needed with seat-belts. Use of seat-belts and the safety railing in the vehicles are strongly encouraged.
