ALDERMANIC REPORTS – Alderman Salomone – BF March 21, 7:15 PM

Auditors presented Fiscal Year 2021 Audit Financial Statement.

Alderman Starkey – rates and ordinance to be updated by city attorney. Water/sewer meeting March 21, 7:00 PM. Sewer ordinance still needs work.

Alderman Cook – Planning and Zoning met to discuss changing 920 W Second Street from school zoning to business, B-1. Planning and Zoning recommended to approve. Alderman Cook made motion to approve. Alderman Temple seconded the motion with Aldermen Salomone, Carbonaro, Huddelston, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple, and Strunk voting yes.

Alderman Temple – body cams/car cams for PD. Chief Brucato received bid. 12 body cams and 6 car cams, including redaction laptop computer and redaction to software/data sever training \$74168.00 which doesn't include install (estimated \$2000.00). Donations in the amount of \$36000.00 received which will come off of the total cost. Alderman Temple made motion to approve. Alderman Strunk seconded the motion with Alderman Salomone, Carbonaro, Huddelston, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple and Strunk voting yes.

Alderman Strunk – Ordinance 870 fee schedule for industrial users. Alderman Strunk made motion to approve. Alderman Carbonaro seconded the motion with Aldermen Salomone, Carbonaro, Huddelston, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple and Strunk voting yes.

Ordinance 871 – water ordinance – \$31.60 base rate, \$2.00 per thousand gallons used, \$7.00 fee remains. This will become effective for April billing, billed in Mary 2022. Alderman Strunk made motion to approve. Alderman Salomone seconded the motion with Aldermen Salomone, Carbonaro, Huddelston, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple and Strunk voting yes.

Department Heads – Scott indicated many water leaks currently; RT 114 will be costly.

#### **Treasurer report –**

**MAYORAL REPORT – lease agreement for the copy machine is due. Prior agreement was \$140.00/month, now will be \$229.95. Alderman Carbonaro made motion to approve. Alderman Cook seconded the motion with Aldermen Salomone, Carbonaro, Huddelston, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple and Strunk voting yes.**

**Ordinance 872 – adding 3 class F liquor licenses, going from 13 – 16 in total. Alderman Carbonaro made motion to approve. Alderman Temple seconded the motion with Aldermen Salomone, Carbonaro, Huddelston, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple and Strunk voting yes.**

**Currently looking for a new firework vendor for this year 4<sup>th</sup> of July celebration. Considering moving from July 4<sup>th</sup> to the 3<sup>rd</sup>.**

**Alderman Cook made motion to adjourn. Alderman Salomone seconded the motion with Aldermen Salomone, Carbonaro, Huddelston, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple and Strunk voting yes.**
