### ROLL CALL

Roll was called by the Clerk with Aldermen Salomone, Carbonaro, Huddelston, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple and Strunk present.

### APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

### ALDERMANIC REPORTS – Alderman Salomone – BF April 4, 7:15 PM

Alderman Carbonaro – Franklin/5<sup>th</sup> street, complaint on pot holes, requesting resurfacing.

Alderman Huddelston – are we still picking up leaves? Residents still putting leaf piles out for pickup. Tina indicated this should resume in mid-April.

Alderman Starkey – sewer ordinance has been received. Letters to be put on the website.

Alderman Temple – complaints on trains blocking crossing. Mayor has spoke to Union Pacific, RFA....no one has any control over this including the government.

Alderman Strunk – Ordinance 873 – sewer rates ordinance, fixed rate 25.88/2.41 per 1000 gallons in water. 44000.00 will be allocated between the industrial users per month. There could possibly be a rate increase May 1 of each year, for April billing. Alderman Strunk made motion to approve. Alderman Salomone seconded the motion with Aldermen Salomone, Carbonaro, Huddelston, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple and Strunk voting yes.
