ROLL CALL

Roll was called by the Clerk with Aldermen Salomone, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple and Strunk. Aldermen Carbonaro and Huddleston were absent.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

Alderman Cook made motion to approve the minutes of the, May 17, 2021. Alderman Temple seconded the motion with Aldermen Salomone, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple and Strunk voting yes.

APPROVAL OF THE BILLS

CITIZENS FORUM –

- i. **Nancy Porter** – Request for Street Closure W. Washington St. Heritage Days – West Washington alley to Dixie. Alderman Cook made motion to approve. Alderman Clark seconded the motion with Aldermen Salomone, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple and Strunk voting yes.
- ii. **Eileen Crook**- Street Closure N. Locust for Heritage Days – North Locust, Washington to Second Street from noon - ? for carriage rides. Alderman Cook made motion to approve Alderman Starkey seconded the motion with Aldermen Salomone, Clark, Starkey, Cook, Temple and Strunk voting yes.

OLD BUSINESS – Alderman Temple – received 2 bids: \$35150.00 and \$52000.00 both would cover construction/warranty. Bid process was discussed with Stewart – does not need to put out for bid, council can decide. This will be put on the agenda to vote next meeting.
